Rendezvous: At 1245 at Region 1 Mark B (RG "A") at Turkey Point.

Radio: Boats should monitor VHF 71 for courtesy communications from the Race Committee.

Start: Between orange flag on Race Committee boat and Region 1 Mark "B" (RG"A"). If code flag "L" is displayed, the starting line may be moved to between orange flag on Race Committee boat and another navigation aid or a temporary drop mark. Temporary mark automatically becomes mark "Y" and may be used as a course mark.

Signals: RRS 26 (Starting Races). Class starts may be combined or split based on number of entries.

Class flag for cruising will be white.*

Course: Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat. Special race buoy drop-marks or government marks based on Region 1 and Region 2 Standard Racing Marks. Detailed race course will be provided in race instructions. Anticipated distances: Multihull and PHRF A – 50NM, PHRF B&C – 35NM, PHRF N & Cruising – 25NM

Finish: Will be at a designated Government Mark at the entrance to Still Pond. Race finishers will enter Still Pond and report finish time (Honor System) to Race Committee.

Time Limit: 18 hour maximum time limit from the starting time for each class shall be imposed for all boats in a class. At the discretion of the Race Committee this time limit may be adjusted, depending on time constraints resulting from any postponements. This changes RRS 35.

Rules: This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013-2016 (RRS). RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, "*If there is a conflict between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing Instructions shall apply.*" All changes to this NOR will be posted on the NERYC website prior to Thursday 17 July 2014.

Protests: Written protests must be submitted to the Post Race Raft-Up and Floating Partin in Still Pond by approximately 0200 hours on Sunday 20 July 2014. Verbal notice of protest delivered to RC boat at finish.

Awards: 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each class awarded via mail or at the Post Race Party at Still Pond on the day after the event. Some fleets may be split for additional awards based on participation.

Social: Let's start a tradition on the Northern Bay! Race down the bay and back, and tie up with NERYC Cruisers at the floating party at the end!
