Course:	Designated by letters and numbers displayed on the Race Committee boat. Special race buoy drop-marks or government marks based on Region 1 and Region 2 Standard Racing Marks. Detailed race course will be provided in race instructions. Anticipated distances: Multihull and PHRF A – 50NM, PHRF B&C – 35NM, PHRF N & Cruising – 25NM		
Finish:	Will be at a designated Government Mark at the entrance to Still Pond. Race finishers will enter Still Pond and report finish time (Honor System) to Race Committee.		
Time Limit:	18 hour maximum time limit from the starting time for each class shall be imposed for all boats in a class. At the discretion of the Race Committee this time limit may be adjusted, depending on time constraints resulting from any postponements. This changes RRS 35.		
Rules:	This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in <u>The Racing Rules of Sailing</u> <u>2013-2016 (RRS)</u> . RRS 63.7, Conflict between Rules, is replaced by, " <i>If there is a conflict</i> <i>between the Event Sailing Instructions and the Notice Of Race, the Event Sailing</i> <i>Instructions shall apply</i> ."
