

The NERYC summer program follows universally accepted methods of teaching sailing and operates within the guidelines prescribed by US Sailing, the national governing body of the sport. Learning, safety and fun are the cornerstones of our curriculum and our campers are taught using a combination of lectures, visual aids, practical drills and extensive on the water practice.

Beginners: Sailors learn the basics of rigging, points of sail, steering, sail trim, knot tying, docking, safety, and basic seamanship.

Intermediate: Sailors begin single-handing and build on the basics as they further develop their seamanship. Sailors are also introduced to the fundamentals of racing at this level.

Advanced: Sailors continue building their skills by working on advanced techniques, expanding their knowledge of the science of sailing sailing, as well as the rules and tactics of racing.

Bay Racers - Travel Team: Qualified sailors receive specialized coaching and compete in regional regattas.

Camp days: Mondays-Thursdays, 9:00am-4:00pm
(Supervised care from 8:30am-4:30pm)



Our team of instructors are all competent sailors specifically selected for their enthusiasm, experience and leadership qualities. Minimum certification requirements: US Sailing Small Boat Level One Instructor, First Aid/CPR, NASBLA Safe Boating, and a MD state approved criminal background clearance.
