RESERVATIONS:

It is required to make slip reservations in advance. Contact the Club via phone/fax or email or contact the dock master Dave Brzezowski directly at 610-308-8708. Prefer large groups arrange visits with the Fleet Captain.

LOCATION:

NERYC is located to starboard of Day Marker 14 (F1 R 2.5secs)

Latitude: 39.57417 (N39-34-27) Longitude: -75.95528 (W75-57-19)

Follow the Channel markers from the Bay at Turkey Point up the North East River.

24 HOUR WASHROOM

ACCESS: Obtain the code from the Dockmaster/Office/Restaurant. The entrance to the wash rooms is located at rear of the clubhouse - follow the walkway on the starboard side as you face the club.

ICE:

Available at \$2.00 per bag. The freezer is located at the rear of the club near the washroom entrance. Obtain the code from the Office/Restaurant/Dock Master.

TRASH / RECYCLING:

Please dispose all trash / recycling in the appropriate dumpster at the rear of the clubhouse.

PUMP-OUT:

Facility is located near the outside corner of D dock. \$5 fee for transients – place money in log book or pay restaurant staff

SWIMMING:

No swimming is permitted within the marina except from the beach

BBQ's:

Charcoal grills are available on the picnic area adjacent to A dock. Please, no grilling on your boat / docks.

RESTAURANT DINING HOURS (may change seasonally):

Dinner Dress: Casual

Winter

Thursdays 5 till 8 pm Fridays and Saturdays 5 till 9pm Sundays 5-8pm (open till 10pm with bar service till midnight for special event and Birthday nights)

Summer

Thursdays 5 till 9 pm Fridays 5 till 10pm Saturdays 4 till 10pm Sundays 4 -9pm (bar service till midnight on Fridays, Saturdays, special events and Birthday nights)

OFFICE HOURS:

MONDAY- THURSDAY 9 AM till 1 PM

PATIO AREA:

No private food or beverages are permitted on the clubhouse patio when the Restaurant/Bar is open.

FISHING:

No fishing within the marina area.

FOUR LEGGED FRIENDS:

Please keep them on a leash, walk them at the far end of the parking lot and use a clean-up bag.

CONDUCT:

This is a private club. Please take care of our wonderful marina, appreciate our staff and officers, and respect the property and sanity of our members.

DOCK RULES:

General rules are available online and are posted on the Dock Bulletin Board, please read and abide by them.

EXCURSIONS:

It is a very short trip into town where you can enjoy unique and quaint gift stores, view the historic buildings or visit the Upper Bay Museum. For the nature conscious, another slightly longer trip in the opposite direction, will take you to Elk Neck State Park where you can picnic, swim, walk the trails or take in the view from Turkey Point Lighthouse. If you are a golfer, you can tackle 18 holes at the nearby Chesapeake Bay Golf Club. It is completely safe to walk or bike around the neighborhood if you just want to stretch your legs or work up an appetite. The Orchard Farm, just along Hance Point Road, is an easy walk. They sell fresh fruit in season. (Go right at the intersection with Bayside Drive)

TRANSPORTATION:

Reasonable & reliable, C & S Taxi Service available 24 / 7 PH: 443 207 0417 / 6194.

PROVISIONS:

There is a bank, ATM and convenience store which also sells liquor approx. one mile from the Club. (Keep left on Bayside then left again on Hance Point Rd.) For anything more substantial you can take a taxi up to the Route 40 business area where there is a Food Lion and Wal-Mart.

CHANDLERY and FUEL:

McDaniel Yacht Basin is less than half a mile north on the river. They have a ship's store and sell fuel. There is a West Marine Store and a Lowes just north of town just before Route 40.
